Intensive preparatory course for Masters/Dr. of Paediatrics exams (Theory, Part I; and Clinical, Part II)

This is the first preparatory course held by the Department of Paediatrics, Faculty of Medicine, UKM, with joint participation by the College of Paediatrics, Academy of Medicine of Malaysia.

This objective of this course is to guide candidates preparing for the exams conducted by the conjoined paediatric specialty training board of UKM, UM, UPM and USM.

The content of this course comprises a comprehensive discourse on the format, marking scheme and guidelines to study on topics frequently asked in the theory paper. For the clinical component, candidates will be taken through the format and expectations required in the various sections of the classical long case, focused history, communication stations, emergency OSCE and short cases. Discussion of scenarios are emphasised and participant interaction with lecturers will be the mainstay of this component of the course. Videos with feedback and demonstration of mock exam cases by select participation of volunteers will also be featured. It is hoped that at the end of this course, participants will be adeptly orientated to the exam format and style and better equipped for self-directed learning in preparation towards passing the exams.

There will only be a maximum of 50 participants for this course. Participants can opt to take only the one-day course for the theory paper (RM300 course fee). Participants for the whole three day course will pay RM900 per person and those who participate hands-on for the mock exam stations will pay an additional RM100 (total fee RM1,000). Only one station is allowed for one participant, and this will be assigned by the course organiser.
